CCAD could not do all the rescue work without the help of foster parents. Barbara Bova has been rescuing animals since she was a young girl. In Minneapolis, MN she worked with the Minnesota Wildlife Sanctuary. When she moved to Severna Park, she trapped and helped many feral cats there and in the Annapolis area. When she moved to Stevensville, she helped at the Chesapeake Wildlife Sanctuary. She now fosters for our organization, opens the Center on Sundays and helps with our outreach program at the new Safeway. She has a love for animals and helping them have a better life.

Carol Eason is another foster mother of cats. She currently has 2 feral kittens that she is trying to tame so they can move into permanent homes. Carol has had success with feral cats in the past.
