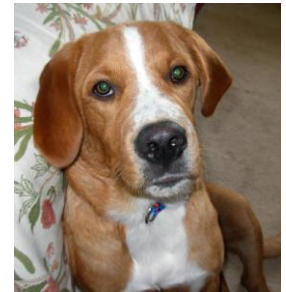

"It is with great sadness that I must tell you that Hobo has gone to heaven now. I am currently out of town visiting my parents. Hobo made the trip with me. He had not been doing well lately. I took him to my mother's vet for evaluation. They agreed that his heart was still a "4" on a scale of 1-6 which is pretty bad. They offered several options, most of which were risky and costly and would require that Hobo be put through more pain. My parents and I discussed this and agreed that Hobo had 5 good months of LOVE and happiness with me and that we could not bear to see him suffer and starve.

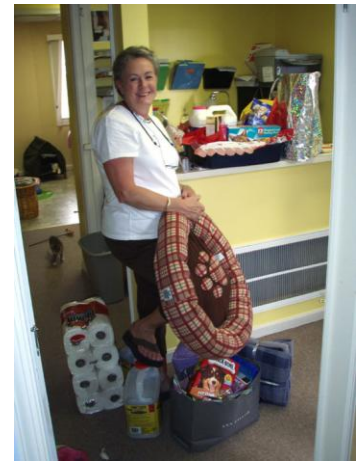
