## Whole Foods Helps Increase Pet Adoptions



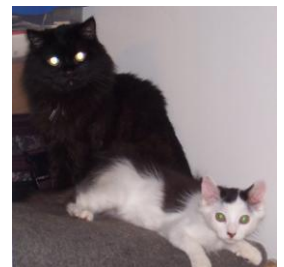

Then one Saturday a lady called and said she had seen Autumn (real name Daisy) on Pet Finder and was coming in to get her. There was no doubt from the staff that Daisy was hers so she was returned.
